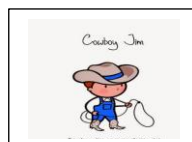
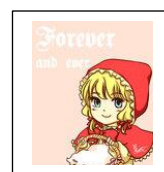
BOOK WEEK/OPEN DAY - AUGUST 13TH
