Working With Children Check

Many parents and community members give up their time to volunteer at our school for various reasons and we are very thankful for that. In 2013 it became a requirement for all people working or volunteering in schools to obtain a 'Working With Children Check' (WWCC). As a volunteer, this means you need to complete and sign a declaration form and show 100 points of identification at the front office. For volunteers there is no cost. If you are a new parent to our school community this year and are involved in a voluntary capacity (eg. Canteen) you may not have yet completed this requirement. If this is the case, please see Rhonda at the office for a WWCC declaration form. Alternatively there are some available in the canteen book.

Dental Clinic

A free dental check-up for all students in kindergarten and year 2 was held at school for all students who returned signed permission notes today. Feedback from the dentist has been sent home with all of the children who received a check-up today.
