NAPLAN

Students in years 3 and 5 will sit the NAPLAN Literacy and Numeracy tests next Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. NAPLAN is a nationwide test that assesses students' basic skills in comparison with students their age around the country. As with any task we ask the children to do at school, it is important they do their best – but it is not something to stress over. The best preparation has already occurred in the classroom and this can be best supported at home by ensuring your child goes to bed at a reasonable hour each night and has a good breakfast each morning. NAPLAN results are usually sent home late in term 3.

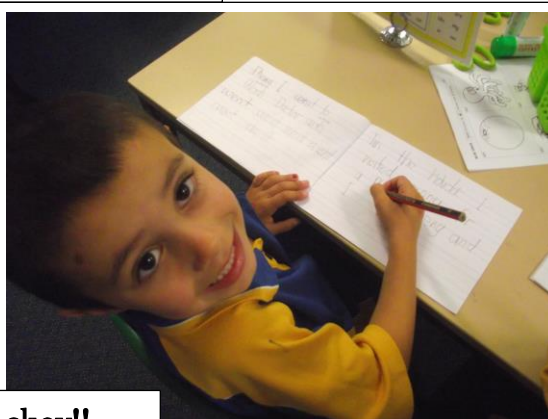
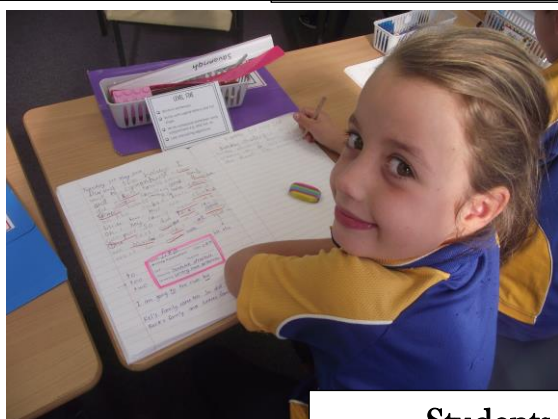
