Principal's report

Presentation night

Our annual Presentation Night is being held at school next Thursday, December 10th. We are starting the evening at 5:30pm with dinner being catered by our P&C. Please consider bringing the family for dinner as this is a fundraiser for our P&C and therefore, our children. The formal proceedings will start at 6:30pm and we would like to have everyone seated by then. Organisation will be as follows:

- Students will sit on matting in front of the 'stage' in their class groups. They will need to be there at 6:20pm.
- Parents, grandparents and other family members are asked to bring fold-up chairs and sit in family groups. Please keep a 2 metre distance between your group and the next and keep your toddlers with you.
- A sign on register will be available for all adult visitors to record their name and phone number.
- Hand sanitiser will be available.
- There is no restriction on the number of family members you bring. This is an outdoor, seated music event which, after Monday, can accommodate up to 500 people whilst complying with social distancing rules. We have over 10000 square metres in which to socially distance.
