Letters home

Children who are continually disobedient or disrupt the learning of others may be asked to leave their classroom. Our school, as most others I suspect, has expectations for positive student behaviour which are not unreasonable. Positive change in a child's behaviour at school is more likely to occur when parents and carers support the school. To encourage this, children who are removed from class will take a letter home stating the inappropriate behaviour. Parents are asked to discuss this with their child, sign the letter and return it to school the next day to indicate that they have received it. If you wish to discuss your child's removal from class, or their behaviour in general, please make a time to talk with their teacher.

School counsellor

We will receive a regular school counselling service for 2021 which equates to one day per fortnight. Parents and teachers are able to refer students to the school counsellor for a range of reasons aimed at supporting their learning and wellbeing and students are able to self-refer if they feel they need to.
