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### **Principal's report**

#### **Clarence District Swimming**

Today Lyla, Olivia, Eligh, Lacey, Rocky and Jeffery are competing as part of the small schools team at the Clarence District Swimming Carnival in Grafton. Our own Mrs Andrews is the organiser for this carnival and I thank her for all of her extra efforts. We hope they have a great day, swim well and I'm sure they will represent our school with distinction. Swimmers who place in the top 3 in each event today will be eligible to compete at the Mid North Coast Swimming Carnival held in Coffs Harbour next week.

#### **Red Rock camp**

Our primary students (yrs 3-6) will have the opportunity to attend our annual overnight excursion to Red Rock this term. We have booked for Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> March (1 night) which is during the last week of term and the kids will come back to finish the term with Old School Day on the Thursday. Notes with all the details will be coming home soon but it might be a good idea to get the tents and swags out and check them over soon! As with last year, only those children whose behaviour at school has been acceptable will be allowed to attend camp – children who choose to misbehave will stay at school. Cost will be the same as last year - \$30.

#### **Cross-country**

Our annual school cross-country races which we missed due to Covid last year will be held at the Copmanhurst Rodeo Grounds on Wednesday, March 17 commencing around 9:30am. Everyone is involved, with our youngest students running 1000m, 8-10 year olds running 2000m and 11 years + students running 3000m. Parents are welcome to attend and may be given a job on the day. Our mates from Baryulgil School will also join us and more details will come home shortly.

Thanks to everyone who provided feedback to the survey that went home in term 4. From the feedback we have received, this year we will once again hold a 'Book Character Parade' where children dress as their favourite book character during Book Week, and we are looking at running a 'Crazy Hair Day' to help raise funds for those suffering with leukaemia. The response to our NAIDOC celebration, where we had the Gurrawin group visit for a day of cultural activities, has been overwhelmingly positive and as a result we are in discussions with the group about a return visit this year with a range of different cultural activities.

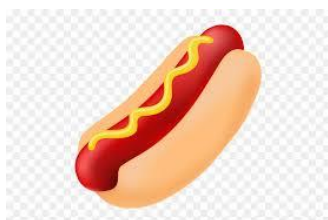
CANTEEN: Ladies if you are rostered on for canteen, can you please bring a cake/slice or pikelets to be sold at recess?
