Principal's report

Yr 6 Transition Day

Our Year 6 students will join other Small School Yr 6 students at the Solitary Islands Resort at Woolli tomorrow as part of their Transition to High School process. They will enjoy activities with students they will be attending high school with next year and will have a chance to engage with and ask questions of their high school year advisors.

Uniform

As we approach the end of the school year, it is important not to slacken off with uniforms. Our students are terrific at wearing their school shirts each day. Should they need a jumper at this time of year, please wear the school jacket or a royal blue jumper. We are not strict on footwear other than insisting kids wear covered in shoes. Joggers are the best, particularly for sport and physical education lessons. Crocs and thongs are not acceptable except on days like swimming or surfing. Please ensure your child wears a hat each day. The school caps or bucket hats are preferred but most other caps are acceptable.
