Principal's report

NAPLAN testing

Due to the school closure we have had to move our NAPLAN testing dates for students in Year 3 and 5 to next week. On Monday, all students in Years 3 and 5 will sit the Writing and Reading tests and on Tuesday they will complete the Language Conventions and Numeracy tests. Each test takes about 40 minutes and is nothing to stress over! Please make sure your child is at school on time these days, having had a good night's sleep and breakfast. This will allow them to perform at their best.

Cross Country Races

Our school cross country races are being held at School on Wednesday March 26th. These races are for everyone from Kinder to Year 6 and will follow a one kilometre track that starts in the school grounds, weaves its way through the village and finishes back inside the school grounds. Students turning 7 or under this year will run one lap, students turning 8-10 this year run two laps and students turning 11 or 12 this year run three laps.
