### Principal's report

#### Cross Country races

#### Copmanhurst ANZAC Service

The main service, which our students and staff will participate in, will commence with a march from Hamilton Park starting at 10:30am for a 10:45am service at the cenotaph. Children should be aiming for a 95% or greater attendance rate in order to get the most out of their learning. Students with an attendance rate below 70% will also be bringing home a letter outlining what needs to be done to improve and what consequences may occur if attendance doesn't improve.
